SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

Endowed scholarship funds help provide the resources necessary to attract talented student-athletes to Georgia Tech. An endowment fund may be named for the donor or for someone the donor chooses to honor.

The Athletic Department's scholarship endowment has a current market value of more than \$30 million, which generates approximately \$1.5 million annually. This means approximately 25 percent of the annual scholarship costs for student-athletes are funded by endowment.

Endowed scholarship funds are invested with the Georgia Tech Foundation (GTF) and earn income in perpetuity for scholarship support. The established annual payout from each endowment typically follows the guidelines established by the GTF. Earnings and appreciation beyond the payout rate are reinvested into the principal amount of the endowment in an effort to grow the endowment to cover inflation.

In the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, a "full ride" scholarship cost the Georgia Tech Athletic Association approximately \$15,000 for in-state and \$30,000 for out-of-state student-athletes. An endowment to support a full athletic scholarship can be established with a gift or multi-year commitment of \$500,000. An endowed partial scholarship fund can be established at a minimum level of \$125,000.

Georgia Tech Athletics Endowed Scholarship Program

An athletic scholarship to Georgia Tech enables a young man or woman to match the full development of his or her athletic potential with the mastery of a challenging academic major at a distinguished university. Such a scholarship also allows coaches to recruit elite student-athletes nationally as they seek those special individuals whose talents will blossom at Georgia Tech.

Endowment Recognition

Full Scholarship Endowment Donors (\$500,000 or more)

- Top-level recognition on wall outside A-T office in Edge building.
- Listed in football game day program and in media guides for sport-specific endowments.
- On-field recognition at football games.
- Scoreboard recognition at football and basketball games.
- Endowment individually named and awarded annually to a student-athlete.
- Invitation to annual Endowment Dinner with student-athletes.
- Priority points are awarded ½ per \$100 on entire pledge at time of commitment with additional 1 point per \$100 with each pledge payment. Endowment donor will also receive 1 point per \$100 on annual amount withdrawn from endowment.

One-half Scholarship Endowment Donors (\$250,000 to \$499,999)

- Name listed on wall outside A-T office in Edge building.
- Listed in football game day program and in media guides for sport-specific endowments.
- On-field recognition at football games.
- Endowment individually named and awarded annually to a student-athlete.
- Invitation to annual Endowment Dinner with student-athletes.
- Priority points are awarded ½ per \$100 on entire pledge at time of commitment with additional 1 point per \$100 with each pledge payment. Endowment donor will also receive 1 point per \$100 on annual amount withdrawn from endowment.

Named Scholarship Endowment Donors (\$125,000 to \$249,999)

- Name listed on wall outside A-T office in Edge building.
- Listed in football game day program and in media guides for sport-specific endowments.
- Endowment individually named and awarded annually to a student-athlete.

- Invitation to annual Endowment Dinner with student-athletes.
- Priority points are awarded ½ per \$100 on entire pledge at time of commitment with additional 1 point per \$100 with each pledge payment. Endowment donor will also receive 1 point per \$100 on annual amount withdrawn from endowment.

Endowment Donors (\$25,000 to \$124,999)

- Endowment individually named and may be awarded to preferred sport.
- Listed in football game day program and in media guides for sport-specific endowments.
- Invitation to annual Endowment Dinner with student-athletes.
- Priority points are awarded ½ per \$100 on entire pledge at time of commitment with additional 1 point per \$100 with each pledge payment. Endowment donor will also receive 1 point per \$100 on annual amount withdrawn from endowment.

Facility Recognition

- Naming opportunities at various levels of support are available within each facility.
- Plaque recognition located on site of all donors to a particular project in alphabetical order. List typically includes all donors to a particular initiative who made a five-year commitment of at least \$25,000.
- Priority points are awarded 2 points per \$100 on all cash gifts. Pledges of \$5,000 or more will receive ½ point per \$100 on pledge and 1 ½ points per \$100 on each pledge payment, if paid at a minimum of annual equal installments over a maximum five-year period.

Note: Recognition and benefits for all endowment and facility gifts are subject to change.
